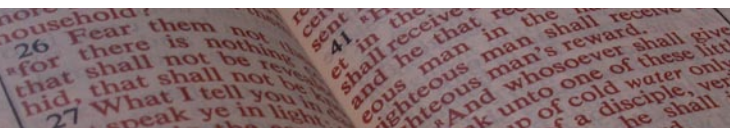

# CEF - LOCAL CHURCH PARTNERSHIP



*Child Evangelism Fellowship*® (CEF) is committed to bring the Gospel faithfully, simply and relevantly to unreached children. We are an international and nondenominational organisation, working in over 155 countries throughout the world.

CEF of Britain has developed the Good News Club® Network as a means to serve and support local evangelical churches in their efforts to reach children for Christ. Clubs are usually held weekly, but may also be bi-weekly or monthly. Some function under the title *Good News Club*®, others have names chosen by the local church. Venues vary from church premises to local schools or community halls.

## The local church

The club is an outreach of the local church and is under its leadership.

The church is responsible for its own child protection policy and relevant checks.

The church provides the teachers and helpers, prays for the club and buys the teaching materials.

The church endeavours to build strong links with the children and their families.



## Child Evangelism Fellowship®

CEF provides free on-going training, ideas and advice – when requested.

CEF provides the yearly core teaching programme (leaving room for flexibility) and makes the teaching materials available for purchase.

Every year CEF will make a free booklet available for each child in clubs affiliated to the Network e.g. a daily devotional or an evangelistic booklet.

When there are several Good News Club® Network outreaches in an area, CEF can help organise an annual special event for the children.
