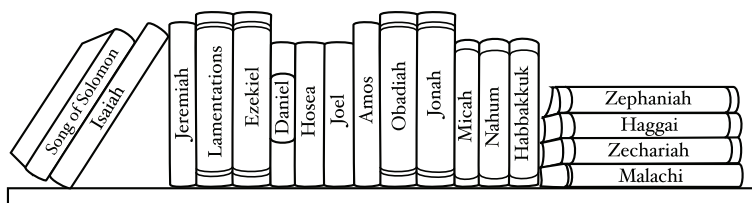
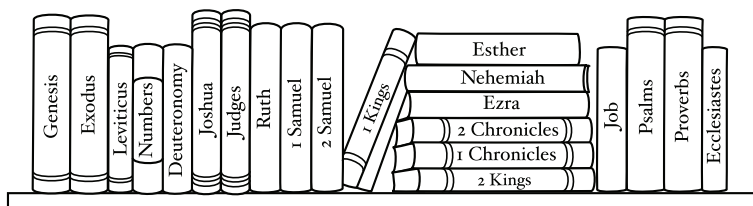

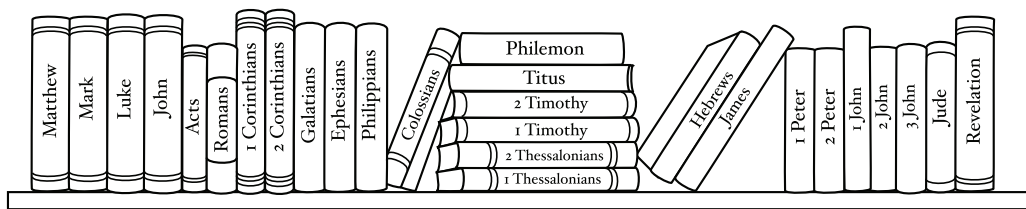
STORY 1: What is the Bible?

The Bible is like a library. Altogether there are sixty-six books in the Bible.

The Bible is divided into two parts. One of these parts is called the Old Testament which tells us about things that happened before Jesus was born. There are thirty nine books in the Old Testament. The other part is called the New Testament and this tells us about all that happened after Jesus was born. There are twenty seven books in the New Testament.

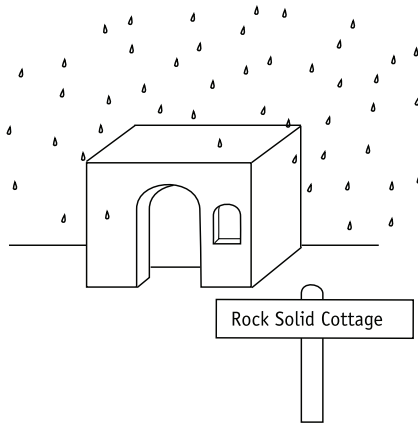

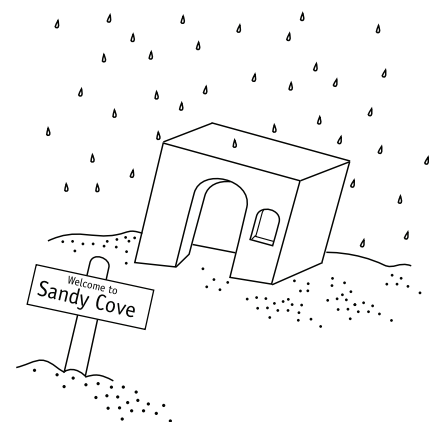

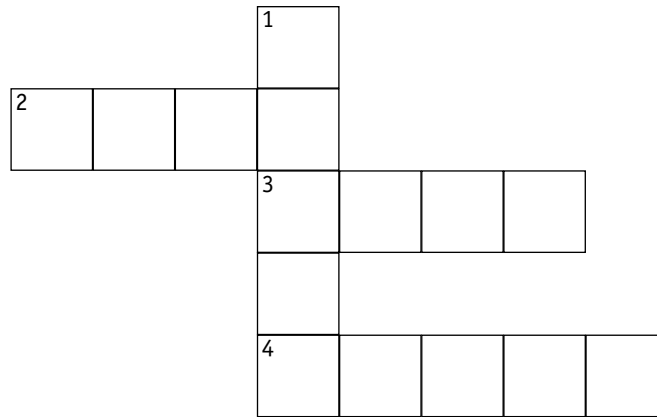
