

Devotional "So be on your guard, not asleep like the others. Stay alert and be clearheaded." 1Thessalonians 5 v 6

The "day of the Lord's return" is a future time when God will intervene directly and dramatically in world affairs. All Christians may not agree on the details of the event, but we cannot escape the reality that someday we shall actually stand before the Lord. How then are we living in the light of this reality? It's good that we don't know exactly when Christ will return. If we knew the precise date, we might be tempted to be lazy in our work for Christ.

The coming again of our Lord Jesus demands certain things of us as believers. We are called to be on our guard, alert and clearheaded. Part of that being alert and clear headed will be watchfulness in prayer. Of course this admonition had a very special meaning for Peter, because he went to sleep when he should have been watching and praying.

You'll often find the phrase watch and pray in the King James Version of the New Testament. It simply means to "be alert in our praying, to be controlled." There is no place in the Christian life for lazy, listless, routine praying. We must have an alert attitude and be on guard, just as the workers in Nehemiah's day were.

An expectant attitude toward Christ's return involves a serious balanced mind and an alert, awake prayer life. I believe that the test of our commitment to the doctrine of Christ's return is not our ability to draw up charts or discern signs, but in our clear, level headed thinking and praying for boys and girls in all manner of situations. If our thinking and praying are right, our living should be right.
