## What does **this** mean?

**Gather:** in the case of a *CEF Good News Club*, it generally concerns children in the 5 to 12 age-range. They can be your own children, neighbours' children, school friends ...

**Hear:** God's Word and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

**Learn:** in an interesting way, using various methods and *CEF* material.

**Fear/trust:** The goal is that children will learn to honour, love and trust Jesus Christ as their



Saviour!

## What is a **Good News Club**?

A weekly Bible class for children, which meets in the local neighbourhood during the school year. Meeting places include homes, recreation centres, schools, community halls and church buildings.

*Good News Club* is the official name that *Child Evangelism Fellowship* gives to these classes.

A Club can also be held on a one-off basis to reach children at a special time of year like a birthday, Christmas or Easter.



## What is the programme?

The main parts of the programme are singing, prayer, Bible Lesson, memory verse and review time. Other items can be included, such as missionary time, crafts, a short doctrine lesson.



The programme usually lasts approximately one hour.

## The value of the **Good News Club**

The *Good News Club* is a Gospel witness, possibly the only one in the neighbourhood.

Children from various religious and social backgrounds are reached right where they live. Many of them do not attend a local Bible-believing church.

Both saved and unsaved children have the opportunity to hear God's Word and respond to it.

Local believers have the opportunity to be used by the Lord in the lives of others.

Entire families can show interest in spiritual things and begin to attend a local church.
