## JUNE '20

These mailings contain a personal greeting, Bible lesson, Memory verse and sometimes a craft or activity.

- 1. John and Martha Meagher (Glasgow)—Praise God for the opportunity John and Martha have to teach at their church's online Sunday School. Pray for help as they continue to learn how to teach online. Ask God to touch the hearts of the children who listen.
- 2. Eun Sook Geum (Northwest London)—Please pray that God will protect Eun Sook's supporters and supporting groups and churches and provide what they need day by day spiritually as well as physically in this current COVID-19 situation.
- 3. David Cook (Chairman)—Praise God for encouraging fellowship each month as the workers meet online to share and encourage each other as they find alternative ways to continue their ministry and reach girls and boys with the gospel.
- 4. Steve and Rachel Ball (East London)—Steve and Rachel have been looking into producing pre-recorded Assemblies for Primary Schools. These would last only 5-10 minutes. Please pray that we would know if and how we should proceed and develop this.
