NEWS FROM CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP IN EUROPE



For the first time, almost all children in Europe are experiencing a global crisis that affects them personally. Within a few days a lot has changed in their lives. The internet has gained enormously in importance and with it so has the children's website *www.wondersurf.com*, which is online in 19 languages and is in preparation for an additional 9 languages.

Three particular features of Wondersurf make it an important website for children now:

1. A message exchange system that is anonymous yet individualised

We are thankful for the short message system that makes it possible for children to come to us with their worries, fears, questions and prayer requests. Every day children write to us in search of answers, security, safety, love...and thus in search of God, who alone can satisfy these needs. It is a great joy that more and more children are asking, "What do I have to do to go to heaven?" or express the desire, "I want to live with Jesus."

2. A fun interactive online-garden

Shortly before the beginning of the crisis period a garden game was finished and added to the website. Children can create their own online garden by earning bonus points from **Continued on page 2**

Gospel; on his way to Rome, he is able to meet with believers (and he didn't need to pay for this himself); all those in the king's court in Rome hear about Jesus Christ and he writes Philippians, Ephesians, Colossians, Philemon and 2 Timothy. For Paul, quarantine was not a crisis, it was an opportunity that served for the *furtherance of the Gospel* (Philippians 1:12).

Looking back, we return our thanks to God for the many, many given opportunities to present the Gospel over these past weeks. *CEF* workers from across Europe worked hard continuing to contact children, teachers and local churches to organise online Good News Clubs and other ministries (Wondersurf, Bible Correspondence Course, Easter Clubs etc.) and online training (in some case with more students than usual). the Bible lessons and adventures. After a few rounds it is time to harvest the garden and receive new bonus points, which can either be invested in the garden or used to support mission projects.

3. A new Wondersurf App

In recent days the German Wondersurf app became available to download from the Google Play Store (https://play.google.com/store/apps/ details?id=com.doromic.GardenApp. de). The app makes it easier and safer for children to use the contents of the website. Development of the app for other languages will begin in August and the development of an iOS version is in the planning.

Another special feature that is currently in development is the Discovery club-Online Bible Reading Clubs

With small groups of children, we would like to read and discuss God's word together on a regular basis, daily if possible, online at Wondersurf. Each group should have 1-2 leaders who will put the Bible text online, start the discussion with a question or thought, check comments from children and share them with the group.

We will start with children who, just like this girl, are already interested in God's word: "I was so happy today! I found a Bible ... and I can keep it! Today I already read through Genesis 1."

In May, we had a total of 18,841 visitors to the website and nearly 450,000 page views of all 19 languages that are online. In June we had 11,846 visitors and 1,011,614 page views. We are so thankful for every child who has stopped by.



CORONA AND THE GREAT COMMISSION

When t h e lockdown, this past spring, very quickly affected one country after another in Europe, we were all surprised at first. From one day to the next, ministries were no longer possible, camps had to be cancelled, any direct contact with children was forbidden. When have we ever seen anything like this? Immediately our workers began to adapt to online teaching and were quickly able to move as much of our ministry as possible online.

Innumerable children's meetings were recorded in our own four walls, in many countries weekly. In Norwegian Lapland, Ida Johnston reached more children in a single live online club than she would normally reach throughout the year. In Denmark, Dorthe Jensen asked the children for prayer requests in a live Zoom club. Suddenly the previously invisible head of a father appeared on the screen. He too wanted to share a prayer request. I assume he was not the only "onlooker" in our online clubs. CEF in Ireland not only ran a whole 5-Day Club® online, but also summer camps. I have seen very nice videos from Portugal and Bulgaria, from Germany and Armenia, from Russia and Ukraine and many other countries. You can find samples in many languages at onlineresources.cefeurope.com.

Most of all I was delighted to observe that a calling remains a calling.

For our leaders and workers, it was clear that the Great Commission would remain unchanged even under corona conditions. With great enthusiasm they have implemented it under the new conditions!

Nevertheless, we are very happy that more and more "real" ministry with children can take place. A lot of creativity is often required here as well. Hygiene concepts must be drawn up and, in some cases, completely new ways of ministry must be developed.

Please pray for our staff in East and West, for their ministries and for their health. Because the Great Commission stands unchanged!

COURSE UNDERWAY-Then Borders Close

IOT COURSE

It was with a heavy heart that on Saturday 15 March we called the students, who were taking the Instructor of Teachers Level 2 (IOT2) course in Sibiu, Romania together. We had just completed the first week of the course when news began to filter through that borders were closing and governments were calling states of emergency because of the COVID-19 pandemic. We made the decision that everyone should pack up and head home as soon as possible (Bosnia-Herzegovina, Serbia, Moldova and within Romania). Praise God everyone got home safely.

Then we faced a new challenge—how to complete the training with everyone hundreds of kilometres apart! Quickly we revised the teaching schedule and moved to the online Zoom platform. On the following Tuesday afternoon, we were back in the "classroom". It was different, a new experience for all of us, but by the end of the first afternoon already we were starting to feel more comfortable with this "new normal." Technology worked well as we met each day and everyone was able to finish the course.

You could be tempted into thinking that this was the end of the story—but it wasn't—in fact it was only the beginning! Already these newly trained instructors have been involved in running their own online training courses—equipping and investing in volunteers (65 until now) to reach and teach children. There are many other stories like this which could be told from around Europe at this extra-ordinary time—Russia, Germany, Lithuania, Portugal, Ireland, Italy, Estonia... Why not pause just now and take a few moments to give Him all the glory because, "This is the Lord's doing; it is marvellous in our eyes." (Psalm 118:23)
