Fix Your Eyes On Jesus (Hebrews 12:1-3)

In November the leaders, in our local church, gave every family a book for Advent. The idea is that everyone will read a chapter each day in December, (I'm sure you get the idea), something like a spiritual Advent calendar but with less calories. This year the book was 'Fixated' by Tim Chester. It led us through some chapters of Hebrews and encouraged us to fix our eyes on Jesus. I want to encourage you to take time to do this at the beginning of 2021. Be encouraged with these words - it's not about trying, by your own strength, to keep up some new year's resolution to be a better Christian, CEF worker, prayer partner, supporter etc. According to Chester, 'to fix your eyes' is a two-step process - to look away and to look to. To look away from the world and ourselves, and to look to Christ.

Hebrews 12:

"1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, 2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy that was set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

Hebrews of course doesn't only give the command, it gives the content. In the first few chapters alone we read how when we fix our eyes on Jesus we see he is the Word, the Son, the radiance of God's glory, the one who finished what God gave him to do, above the mighty angels, the King, the Creator, our Salvation and on and on it goes.

Recently I read these words that have been attributed to Corrie Ten Boom. "If you look at the world, you'll be distressed. If you look within, you'll be depressed. But if you look at Christ, you'll be at rest."

I'll leave it up to you to think about what's going on in the world that has the potential to bring you distress, or the circumstances in your life that could make you feel depressed. I'm sure it's different for all of us individually. But I want us to be encouraged that fixing your eyes on Jesus is the answer.

So, let us fix our eyes on Jesus and enjoy his rest, his peace, and joy in our lives together as we serve him.
