## Dear Friends,

I am thrilled that you have decided to follow my journey as I enter children and youth ministry with Child Evangelism Fellowship® (CEF). I am delighted to have been accepted as a Candidate in Training with CEF and will be completing my training over the next twelve months. Through these letters I hope to share with you my journey and encourage you to pray for the work of the gospel with children and young people in South Wales.

### WHAT IS CEF?

Child Evangelism Fellowship® is a Bible-centred organisation, composed of born-again believers.

- To edify (disciple) them in the Word of God
- To establish them in a local church for Christian living.

## The Story So Far

Over the last few years I have had the privilege to volunteer and run several children and youth ministries. During this period, I have attended conferences and training days to equip me further as a children's worker. Through these experiences, my heart for children and young people to come to faith has grown; it has been wonderful to be able to sow seeds of faith in my community. My local church has watched me grow in confidence, recognising my calling to work with children and youth.

As part of creating exciting events for the children in my local area, I met up with Hanne Evans who encouraged me to join CEF. I applied for the Children's Ministry Leadership Course (CMLC), which was to be held in Romania last summer, but this was postponed because of the Covid-19 Pandemic. This year's training in Romania has also been cancelled, but I am excited to be joining the course online this summer. In the meantime, I am studying other CEF online courses. I have completed the a foundation course called 'Equip' which took place during January.

Since February I have been completing CEF's 'Teaching Children Effectively™ Level 1'. This training course is designed to offer a fresh approach to evangelising and discipling children. I have been learning new methods and procedures to lead children to Christ and help them grow in their faith.
