When I was a teenager quite often I was asked 'What do you want to be when you grow up?' and I've had many different desires about what I wanted to do but I've always told myself that I want to be the person that I would have needed when I was younger. For many years I thought that meant that I needed to be a psychologist or a Christian counsellor but every time I tried getting into that profession the doors would close and I couldn't understand why.

Until the year 2019, when things changed significantly in my life. I had to leave my job and move to a different country.
