"LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT": A NEW DEPARTMENT IN CEF EUROPE

Imagine an eight-year-old boy sitting in a Good News Club, surrounded by boys and girls his age, hearing the gospel in his language and at a level he can understand. Standing in front of this boy and his friends is a CEF-trained volunteer who took a Teaching Children Effectively course that was led by a local worker. This local worker took an Instructor of Teachers course which was led by a country education coordinator. This education coordinator works in a national office and is led by a national director. This director oversees the ministry on a national level—supporting the education coordinator, who supports the local worker, who supports the volunteer, who teaches the eight-year-old boy and his friends sitting in the Good News Club.

Support and training are available for almost every person in this scenario. But who is there to develop and train the national leader? Historically, there has been no consistent, designated training programme in place to help develop national leaders in CEF. This is now changing.

As the newly-formed European Leadership Development department, our vision is to see God's glory declared among the children of Europe through gospel centred leadership. We believe that at the core of a thriving national ministry is a thriving national leader, and at the core of a thriving national leader is a heart rooted and grounded in the gospel. It's not enough for national directors to just know general leadership principles and CEF procedures, although these are very important. We want to see leaders who have eyes that see every opportunity and challenge through the lens of God's Word and hearts that are resting in His grace.

Whether national ministries are thriving or dwindling, leaders need the gospel (as we all do). They

need the gospel, so they do not become puffed up in pride at their success, and they need the gospel so they are not left in despair at their shortcomings. Ultimately, we want all of our leadership development to have its footing in the truth of God's Word.

How will this be accomplished? We hope to see this vision fulfilled through various means. A website is currently being designed, which will be updated each month with articles, videos, and other resources to encourage and equip national directors in their leadership and their walk with God. This website is set to be launched in September.

Alongside the website will be short online training courses, written and taught specifically with the CEF national leader in mind. We hope to launch the first of the short courses in January 2022.

God willing, in-person leadership development training will be possible in the coming months. We hope to put on conferences and training events for national leaders in different locations and capacities. One-to-one coaching has also started with some national directors, and we trust that this has been a blessing and help.

Will you pray with us as we continue in this new endeavour? First, ask the Lord to fill and change our hearts with the gospel. Then ask Him to help us minister gospel centred truth to the national directors. Pray that CEF Europe would be a ministry marked by gospel centred leadership.

As leaders grow and thrive in the gospel, there will be a ripple effect. They will be a blessing to the department leaders and local workers, who in turn will be a help and blessing to the volunteers, who—at the end of it all—will bless the unreached children with the Good News of Jesus!

25 YEARS OF HELPING!

"Lord, what do You want me to do now?" This was Sam Doherty's big question when he 'retired' from the leadership of CEF Europe after 29 years. As Sam prayed about this, it became clear that there was a mighty work to do in writing and publishing literature to help and encourage children's workers around the world. Such a ministry would be based on the many lessons Sam had learned over the years. After some time of planning and organising, a charitable trust was formed to govern the work commencing on 29 August 1996. The name given to the trust was "Assisting Children's Evangelists Worldwide" (ACEW) with the particular aim of helping CEF workers. Eventually the



onmission is distributed three times a year free-of-charge by the European Headquarters of Child Evangelism Fellowship®.

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

The first book published was The

Problems of Children's Workers and God's Solution. This book proved to be a great encouragement to many struggling workers as they learned to trust God. The ink in Sam's pen began to flow as book after book was published and over 50 titles of training manuals, devotional books and also a series of visualized doctrinal lessons were available. In addition, 52 small booklets were produced covering subjects applicable to children's ministry. Much credit is due to Isobel Metcalf (Sam's Secretary) who took Sam's handwritten notes and transcribed them for the printed page. Terry Flannigan became the administrator of the Trust, and a team of volunteer workers was assembled to handle the big task of mailing the books to thousands of workers around the world. God provided a base for the work in offices kindly provided in Lisburn, Northern Ireland.

As the work grew many books were translated into over 70 languages including Chinese, Russian, French, Spanish, and Hindi. In several countries these publications became the means God used to extend and strengthen the work. In using these publications CEF Ghana says, "Our knowledge and understanding of concepts and principles have been greatly enhanced". In Nepal, the work has grown as the workers have been equipped with study books and teaching tools giving the work stability. The CEF Leader says, "It was a 100 percent blessing for my ministry, a work that has now grown to 13 workers". Such publications gave strength and dignity to the work.

A more recent development has been the production of "Mini Mag" a digital tool written to develop the spiritual understanding of children's workers as well as giving training on ministry.

In an amazing way God has provided the large amount of finance needed so that millions of books have been distributed at little or no cost to the worker.

Today the work continues as many children's workers access the resources available online at www.CEFBookMinistry.com.

25 years of helping has brought untold blessing to countless children's workers around the world and to thousands of precious children.
