Western Europe Prayer Diary August & September 2021

Devotional

Psalm 103

In this Psalm of David, we can find much to encourage us to pray. There are 3 key elements within the Psalm: -

- 1) The Praise of God
- 2) The Compassion of God
- 3) The Rule of God

Firstly then:

The Praise of God

Praise aught always to be an important element in our prayers. Will you always feel like praising God in your prayers? The simple answer is no. No doubt the same was true for David and maybe so in Psalm 103 which is why the Psalm begins with David speaking to himself. In verses 1 & 2 David tells himself to praise God with all of his being, which may be his way of reminding himself that he needs to praise God regardless of how he is feeling. I don't know whether you are at an age where you talk to yourself, but I'm giving you permission to talk to yourself today and remind yourself that you will surely bring glory to God by praising His name! David praises God for His many mercies including forgiveness of sins v3a; healing of sickness v3b; deliverance from death v4a; and the enrichment of his life with God's great love and compassion v4b. Try drawing up a list today of what God has done for you - over your life time - in these recent months - even over the last day or two.

The Compassion of God

The dictionary definition of the word compassion is usually summed up in the words pity or mercy. However, the compassion of God is more than feelings of pity or mercy, God's feelings of compassion lead to action to do something about the situation.

In Psalm 103 David recalls the covenant loyalty of Almighty God to His people Israel despite their sinfulness and frailty. And in just the same way each one of us have experienced God's compassion towards us. In verse 10 it says "He will not always chide..." In some versions "accuse,"....literally He will not bring a court case against us. He certainly could bring a court case against us and with ample evidence to see us convicted as charged. However, verses 10 & 11 remind us, "As far as the east is from the west, so far does He remove our transgressions from us." Christ has removed our sin, borne our shame, carried our guilt. Why has He shown such compassion to us? He knows our weakness and frailty whereby we cannot help ourselves and are eternally lost.

Made of dust, we are remarkably insignificant. No matter how great our life's achievements, life is brief and transitory. The eternal, covenant love of our God is all that we have to hold on to. The psalmist tells us that God's great love is toward those who obey Him and keep His commandments. In our weakness we are utterly dependent on the compassion of our loving Heavenly Father.

The Rule of God

I love how the Psalm starts out with the praise of God and ends up with the rule of God. You'll either have heard the question being asked or asked it yourself at some time, "Who is in charge around here?" When we know who is in charge it makes all the difference. David assures us, "The Lord has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all." David wasn't waiting patiently to find out who would come out on top. He knew that God was over all and so all angels, all heavenly hosts, indeed all creation should praise the Lord! What a difference to our praying this simple fact makes. We are praying to the One who is sovereign over all. Our requests are being heard by the One

who is in charge. He can answer in whatever way is pleasing to Him. Let's give praise to our God through our

prayers over these months. Let's praise Him for His compassion towards us, His weak and sinful people. However, let's not forget that He rules and that He rules over all things, people and situations. Nothing is too difficult for Him!!

August 2021

1. France:

Pray for a residential TCE 1 & 2 which will take place from today until the 7^{th,} and also for an IOT 1 & 2 course starting on August 14th. May the Lord allow these trainings to take place despite Covid.

5. Great Britain:

Praise God that Liz from Switzerland has been accepted to join CEF Britain as a volunteer after the first half of her CMLC training is completed in August. Pray that Liz and her husband Micha, accepted to study for a Masters' degree in Theology at Union School of Theology in Bridgend, South Wales, will be able to complete their move to South Wales during August.

6. Chris & Lynn Holt, European Member Care:

Pray for God's comfort and support for those within CEF who have recently lost loved ones.

7. Portugal:

Praise God for those children saved at the Word of Life Camp at which Jovanka was teaching in July. We rejoice that 12 children put their trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and 5 children rededicated their lives to the Lord. Ask that God would continue to give opportunities to disciple these boys and girls in the months ahead.

8. Austria:

Pray for the few contacts we have made. They have been doing TCE online. Pray this will result in children being reached with the gospel directly.

9. Italy:

Praise God for the success of the recent literature project led by Gary Cortes. Continue to pray that God will use the "What Children Really Need to Know" booklet as it comes into the hands of boys and girls in Italy. Remember as Gary now plans a second literature project using the message of the Wordless Book and the wristband based on the colours of the Wordless Book. He would like to produce 50,000 copies of this second booklet for distribution by June 2022.

10. Switzerland:

Pray for a number of churches and individuals, over 150 in number, who have received our 'get to know' folder over the last few months. We would like to follow up and, where possible, offer help for the work among children.

11. Germany:

Please pray that God will open many doors for ministry in our schools and also that God will help us to start many Good News Clubs after the summer vacation.

12. Spain:

Please continue to pray for urban camps, five day Clubs, and evangelistic campaigns in different parts of Spain. Pray that lives will be changed by the gospel.

13. Bogdan Bassara: International Literature Director

Please pray for all the translations that are happening into 38 European languages. Pray for more translators into languages where there is a very small Christian community. Pray for finances needed to pay for translations.

14. Ireland:

We are trusting that some 5-Day Clubs and Holiday Bible Clubs can be conducted throughout this month. Pray that the Lord will keep everyone safe and that His Word will go forth to precious boys and girls without too many interruptions.

Praise God for the opportunity to take time out this month for a family holiday and as part of that spend time with family in England. Please ask God to provide personal refreshment at all levels, physical and spiritual.
