This summer I have been blessed to have successfully completed part one of the Children's Ministry Leadership Course (CMLC). The 9 week online training was exciting and challenging. Working with students across Europe we were taught gospel-centred ministry which prepares us to evangelise unreached children with the Word of God. Every module weaves together to put Christ at the centre of everything, from studying the Biblical basis of child evangelism, doctrine, ministries to reach and teach and interpreting scripture.

WHAT IS CEF?

Child Evangelism Fellowship® is a Bible-centred organisation, composed of born-again believers.

Their purpose is:

- To evangelise boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ
- To edify (disciple) them in the Word of God
- To establish them in a local church for Christian living.

Biblical Training

CEF has a unique way of delivering a detailed Biblical curriculum. My favourite module was Visual Communication, finding creative ways to present memory verses and songs.

Our assignments gave us opportunities to work individually, in pairs and groups when preparing practical demonstrations. It was wonderful to 'meet' such wonderful teachers who are inspirational in what they do. The final part of the course will run in the Spring in Romania, and in Ireland in the Autumn. Although I would love to complete the course in Ireland with the other UK students, I have a real desire to complete the course as soon as possible to begin work in earnest. So, God willing, Romania, here I come!

God has been so good in answering prayer. At the moment I am the only CEF worker in training in Wales. However, on the course I met a fellow student, Liz. In the last week of the course, she and her husband Micha moved from Switzerland to Wales, where her husband is studying at Union School of Theology. Liz is now supporting the outreach I am doing.
