CHRISTMAS IN UKRAINE

On Tuesday, Russia launched 100 missiles at Ukraine, targeting their power systems and energy infrastructure. Due to this attack, the Ukrainian government began introducing emergency electrical outages in all regions of the country to stabilize power.

Praise God for safety of the Romanian team as they traveled to Ukraine Wednesday morning. They had a safe and uneventful border crossing. That evening, 30 teachers attended the Christmas Party Club (Christmas Together) training. There was no electricity after 3 PM, but the training continued as planned.

Those who didn't attend the training prepared Gospel bags for orders that have been placed in different parts of the country. Please pray that they will be a great blessing to the children who receive them.
