Dear prayer partners,

The book of Haggai is a small book consisting of just two chapters yet; this small book has much to teach us about persistence in the work of God. The Jews had returned to their home country and had started to rebuild the temple, but this had been brought to a sudden end due to opposition. In the first chapter God rebukes his people for their interest in their homes and their welfare while the house of God had been left desolate. The Word of God was spoken through Haggai asking the people to "consider their ways", to take a good long look at where their priorities lay. It is encouraging to read in ch 1 v 14 "and the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel....and the spirit of Joshua....and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God."

We would ask you to pray that God will "*stir up*" each one of us at this time and that we will have a willing spirit to work for His kingdom. Pray that He will "*stir up*" others to get involved with the work of CEF that we will see the Gospel shared with many more children across Western Europe.
