- Finland: We have tried to think of different ways to celebrate this year our 50th anniversary. In addition to the monthly literature discounts, we are planning to organise some events in the fall and maybe launch a booklet that gives the Biblical basis for children's ministry and also publish a general brochure about us. Please pray that the Lord would guide us to spend our time and resources wisely. There is no need to focus on us as an organisation, but on the Lord who has been so good and faithful to us for more than 50 years.
- Greece: Please, pray for the building of the two new cabins at the CEF camp in Thessaloniki. May all the work progress go smoothly and quickly with no problems or delays.
- Germany: We thank the Lord for a very blessed conference for our workers and missionaries. Continue to pray that the Lord guides and gives us two workers with a calling to bring the message of the cross to the children in Berlin.
- Sweden: Pray for the small Swedish team. Pray for health, strength and wisdom over the team.

Great Britain: Hope for Europe Project. Pray that the delivery by Royal Mail Door to Door drop of 150,000 copies of the "Do You Wonder Why?" and "Meet the King" booklets in April to homes in England, Scotland and Wales will be gospel seeds sown and bear much fruit in the lives of girls and boys and their families.

1	Latvia: Pray that we can finish preparing the materials for the Camps and that we can offer them to the camp teams at the beginning of May.
2	Spain & Portugal: Pray for the latest preparation details for the CMLC in Portugal. May God help us in all the preparations, and he calls students to serve him with CEF in Portugal and Spain.
3	Sweden: Pray for the Summer planning. Pray for more volunteers.
4	Greece: Please, pray for two big one day children's events coming up. On 6 <sup>th</sup> May we will have more than 100 children in Athens and on 13 <sup>th</sup> May we will have it in Thessaloniki, with evangelistic lessons, verse, puppet plays, games and food. God may talk to the children's hearts.
5	Ireland: We are having our Equip 23 Conference in Dublin tomorrow 6 <sup>th</sup> May. Pray for those who are taking part and sharing about equipping believers to teach the next generation.
6	Italy: Please pray for the Board and Assembly meeting today that they will know God's presence and discernment as they plan for

ministry in the coming months.

Great Britain: As the coronation of King Charles III takes place, pray that the distribution of thousands of copies of the "Meet The King" booklets will prompt children in Britain to discover Jesus, the King of Kings for themselves and put their faith in him.

- Finland: Thank God for the interest in our new Survival Camp package, especially among men. Please pray that the effort we put into translation and adaptation would not be in vain, but would bear fruit in the lives of many children who go to camps where this material is being used. Pray that many camps would be organised this summer and pray for those who are planning camps at the moment that they would hear about this package, choose the best ideas for their situation and put a lot of emphasis on the John the Baptist Bible lessons.
- France: From the 8th to the 11th of May there will be a course on child evangelisation in the Bible Institute in Geneva. Pray that the students will be sensitized to the spiritual needs of children and that they will form relationships with future church pastors.
- Cyprus: Andrew and Beulah McMullan will visit the CEF ministry in Cyprus for the first time. They'll meet the N. Board, the volunteers and share news in a number of local churches. Please pray that their visit will be fruitful for the glory of God and the progress of the work among the children.
- 10 Ireland: 10<sup>th</sup> May we will be holding our Members' Meeting. Pray for each Local Committee member who attends that they will be encouraged and challenged regarding ministry in their local areas.
- lulian and Anca Mangalagiu: Please pray that God will give us wisdom in knowing how to use as efficient as possible the Hope for Turkey project to help children learn about God the only hope. As the distribution of brochures or other evangelistic tools is not possible, we need to work through churches. Please pray for good contacts.
- Belgium: Pray for finishing the AEE/IKEG website for both the Flemish speaking part as well as the French speaking part. Pray for a smooth launch!
- Member Care: Pray that God will use the Member Care literature Chris and Lynn distribute to encourage and strengthen the workers throughout Europe.
- Lithuania: Pray for preparation for summer camps, for volunteers and for families that they would be able to pay the increased prices for camping. Pray for sponsors for those who cannot afford sending kids to CEF camp.
  - Pray for new workers and more volunteers to be equipped for reaching children through training and materials.
- Andrew and Beulah McMullan: Please pray as we visit Cyprus from 15<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> May that God will go before us preparing the way and that we will have many divine appointments during this visit.

Would you please pray that God would send someone that could help Satu every now and then, so that she would not feel too much pressure during the peak seasons or in case of illness? 21 Great Britain: Praise God for interest in training from church leaders in different parts of Britain. Continue to pray for the chaplains from "Kick" as they complete the "Equip" online training course in May. Norway: Please pray for contacts in the southern part of the country. 22 Greece: Please, pray for the financial funding of the building works at 23 the CEF camp in Thessaloniki. May God will put the burden in the hearts of many Christians to support this building work, as it will be a great tool for the building of the lives of many children. 24 Switzerland: Please pray for Daniela as she works in the office. Pray for the Lord to send us workers so we can begin to work directly with children soon. 25 Southwest Europe Leaders meeting. Pray for the country leaders in SW Europe as they gather with the Regional Director and Department leaders to consider the way ahead for the ministry throughout the European region. Ireland: Some school-based 5-Day Clubs will be commencing this 26 month. We are thankful for the opportunities to reach into schools with the gospel message. Pray that children will be enthusiastic in attending the clubs. EPM: we praise God for all he has provided and pray he continues to 27 provide for us throughout the year. Pray for new contacts to start supporting the shortfall ministry.
