Statistics:

4,261,400 Do You Wonder Why booklets have been printed and many of them already distributed. 135,000 backpacks, pens and Meet the King booklets have been purchased. They are at various stages. Over 122,000 backpacks have been filled and taken into Ukraine or given to Ukrainian children living in Europe. 125,316 Gospel bags have been prepared from Romania, Poland and Czech Republic.
