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


OUR HISTORY

We praise the Lord that we have shared the Gospel with over 350 million children in the last 86 years.




OUR STRATEGY

Because of God's great heart for the lost and His desire that none should perish, He has guided us to an effective threefold strategy: Train, Equip, and Support.

- Training prepares men and women to effectively evangelize and disciple children.
- Equipping provides trained men and women with the tools they need to evangelize and disciple children.
- Supporting provides financial resources to trained and equipped men and women so they can maintain focus on evangelizing and discipling children.

OUR MISSION

Child Evangelism Fellowship is a Biblecentered organization composed of bornagain believers whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the Word of God and in a local church for Christian living.



The ministry of CEF is founded on Scripture. We have shaped our vision and our mission after the teachings of Scripture, and our culture points are also supported by the Word of God. All these support our strategy for bringing the Gospel to Every Child, Every Nation, Every Day.

OUR VISION

Because the Lord is not wishing that any *should perish*, our vision is Every Child, Every Nation, Every Day. It is our goal to reach every child with the life-transforming message of the Gospel. For this reason, we actively pursue establishing the ministry in **every nation** on earth. We provide children's apps, devotional books, and growth materials to children so they may grow in God's Word every day.



TRAIN

TRAINING is the first step in our strategy to reach children for Christ. Every corporation understands the benefits and necessity of training to ensure consistency. CEF has trained millions of people, and we have found that training is essential for at least five reasons:

1. TRAINING PRESERVES THE BIBLICAL MODEL.

Paul instructed Timothy, "What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also" (2 Timothy 2:2). Training provides a wonderful opportunity to disciple the future leaders of our ministry. We train volunteers and staff, as well as provide ongoing education for instructors to constantly sharpen their skills and carry out the mission God has given us.

2. TRAINING PRODUCES **EFFECTIVENESS.**

Understanding the job is an essential element in enhancing our ministry. CEF continues to learn from what has been done before. Our training programs provide information on many topics—from current issues to agegroup characteristics to essential leadership practices and more—so that we are ready to communicate the Gospel clearly and effectively.

3. TRAINING PROVIDES CONFIDENCE.

If workers lack confidence, they may never take the next step, but when they are confident, they can boldly move forward. CEF training not only provides classroom instruction; it also gives workers opportunities to put into practice what they learn. Through triedand-tested practicums, students gain the confidence they need.

4. TRAINING PROMOTES MULTIPLICATION.

Trained CEF workers are multipliers. A national worker shares the Gospel with as many as 6,000 children annually. Those young disciples go and make more disciples, sharing the Good News with their peers and families. Thousands of them are even inspired to pursue CEF training.

5. TRAINING PREVENTS **MISSION DRIFT.**

Lastly, countless ministries lose their way after years of faithfulness. One need only look at the educational institutions that were founded to train preachers: Harvard, Yale, Princeton, and many more. Training makes clear what is expected. By God's grace, CEF has stayed true to its founding principles and training is an important part of that process.

CEF has trained nearly 9.8 million people in person and online!

The Love of God

Angela Thornton, a US-sent missionary to Lesotho, completed the Teaching Children Effectively[™] Level 1 course online and immediately put her training to work. Angela shares, "A group of 21 Basotho children—ranging from 2 to 12-years old—crammed into a small oneroom house to listen to me teach. Many Basotho children believe that God cannot love them because of their sin. As I was sharing the gold page of *The Wordless Book* with them, I had the privilege of telling them about the God who created them and loves them, in spite of their sin. Eleven children accepted Jesus as Savior!"



EQUIP

Anyone who has done construction work knows that having the right tools to do the job makes an incredible difference in maximizing efficiency and minimizing frustration. There are over 40 different types of hammers on the market and each one is designed for a specific job. The framing hammer's length is designed to measure the distance between studs. The joiner's mallet is made of soft wood to prevent bruising or marring the wood. The upholstery hammer is designed to drive tacks. At CEF we have writers and editors who work to design tools for specific jobs.



>> Do You Wonder Why? is designed to help children cope with crisis and answer the questions they face. "Does God know and care about me?" "Why do so many bad things happen in the world?" "How could God allow this to happen?" It gives Gospel answers to their difficult questions. The booklet has been used to minister to children in Ukraine during the war, in Syria following the earthquake, and in other areas following school shootings or natural disasters.

GOD IS STILL IN CONTROL

Over 35,000 Do You Wonder Why? booklets have been printed in Arabic and continue to be distributed throughout the nation of Syria since the earthquake on February 6, 2023. These booklets are bringing the message of the Gospel, the message of hope, to children like U. "When the earthquake happened, I thought God had lost control of the earth," U said. "But when I read this book, I knew the truth that God still controls everything."

"We were teaching from the series God Rules: Be Strong, which is about Daniel. On week four we told the children about the time God wrote on the wall in Belshazzar's court. Just as Belshazzar was afraid, Vanessa* was afraid. When I spoke with her, I explained to her there was no reason for her to be scared. I told her God is powerful and does things to show His power and His love for people. That was when she said yes to Christ. That was when she put her faith in Jesus as Savior."

SUPPORT

SUPPORTING is the third step in the *CEF* strategy to effectively evangelize and disciple boys and girls. The primary means of supporting national missionaries is the Sponsor-A-National Program. Simply put, SPAN™ makes sense:

- NATIONAL MISSIONARIES KNOW THE **LANGUAGE.** Once they receive training, there is no down time; they can go straight to work evangelizing and discipling children.
- NATIONAL MISSIONARIES UNDERSTAND **THE CULTURE.** Since they are native to their country, they can easily avoid awkward cultural mistakes. They also understand the best way to communicate the Gospel in their culture.
- NATIONAL MISSIONARIES ARE THE LEAST **IMPACTED BY POLITICAL CRISIS.** Often. cross-cultural missionaries are forced to leave the field when crisis comes. Nationals can stay and minister during the crisis.

NATIONAL MISSIONARIES ARE THE MOST **ECONOMICAL WAY TO REACH CHILDREN.**

Although SPAN support varies by region, the average missionary can be supported for just \$3,600 annually. That's only \$15 per day or \$75 per week.

The number of missionaries sponsored through SPAN has increased dramatically from 563 in 2014 to 1,356. In just a decade the program has more than doubled in size! Plans are in place to support more national missionaries through SPAN as the Lord provides the needed funds. We would like to support 300 more missionaries in 2023 from over 140 countries where it is difficult or impossible for missionaries to raise their full support. Please pray with us that God will provide the missionaries and financial resources to accomplish this growth.



Without the help of SPAN support, I might have returned to the garage to practice my trade of sheet metal welding and automotive painting, only being able to continue in the ministry as a volunteer. SPAN is a powerful tool God uses for the survival and expansion of CEF ministry."

CITY GROWTH MATCHING GRANT REACHES MORE CHILDREN

he Apostle Paul set his eyes on Rome as a target city for the Gospel. Paul knew that Rome, as a major city, was situated at a crossroads and that from there the Gospel could spread throughout the country and continent. At *CEF*, we want to give attention to our cities because 80 percent of the American population now lives in urban areas¹. A new initiative is helping to grow ministry in Baltimore, Houston, and Minneapolis by providing a matching grant for ministry expansion. In Minneapolis, the matching grant allowed the Twin Cities to bring on Tim Pressley as a ministry coordinator. Tim has already been instrumental in starting five new Good News Clubs and connecting with churches to launch more clubs. According to Joseph Rukavina, the CEF Twin Cities local director, the grant has already made it possible for hundreds of kids in the Twin Cities area to hear the Gospel, and it has allowed the chapter to accomplish very quickly what it would have taken years to accomplish without help.

USA Ministry Bounces Back!

ike many ministries, *CEF* in the USA was impacted by the pandemic. In March 2020, face-to-face ministry came to a screeching halt, and COVID-19 continued far longer than any of us expected. *CEF* workers and volunteers took the bull by the horns and began conducting *Good News Club* on *Zoom*°. Still, they knew nothing could replace in-person interaction with children. Thankfully, 2021 had a full year of impact, and amazingly, in 2022, the Lord gave us a 62 percent increase in the number of children reached. In addition, God blessed us with 85 percent more children attending GNC™. The Lord enabled us to add 12 new state directors and 104 additional staff across the USA.

Local Director Assistance Program Continues to Aid Growth

hrough the Local Director Assistance Program, local chapters receive a grant to help place directors in their chapters. Currently, 44 local areas are participating and receiving salary assistance, training, and materials for ministry. God has provided funds for ten additional grants, and we look forward to how He will continue to grow the number of children reached in the USA.



I (Doug) grew up reading the Bible and attending church weekly. At Bradley University, my friend challenged me to diligently study my faith so I could articulate it. The process was challenging but expanded my understanding of my sin, God's grace, and the need for Jesus' sacrifice. It left me wanting to grow in my knowledge of the Bible and theology.

I enrolled in Wheaton College's Bible program, where I met a beautiful woman from Texas, Martha. After we married, we settled near Chicago. As Sunday school teachers, we taught the children Bible lessons full of good morality; however, we didn't help them understand their need for a Savior. I often wonder how many of those children still continue in the faith.

Martha grew up in a Christian home and accepted Christ as her Savior at age four. She fondly remembers attending *Good* News Club at a neighbor's house. She was unaware of the CEF international ministry until we attended a Good News Gathering[™] in Hilton Head.

In 2017, we had the privilege of visiting Good News Clubs in Africa and participating in the dedication of the CEF

Children's Center in Nairobi. Over 1,800 children attended that day! We visited school rooms where students sat—three at each desk—with no pictures on the walls, and no pencils or papers; only the brightly colored CEF materials were seen. Yet, the students listened to the lesson attentively and their responses demonstrated an amazing knowledge of theology gained from CEF discipleship.

In 2022, we also attended the CEF Regional Conference in Germany. We enjoyed meals, fellowship, worship, and singing in many languages with workers from all over Europe—a glorious foretaste of heaven!

Seeing CEF share the Gospel so well, in a way that children understand, has captured our hearts. While enrolled in Teaching Children Effectively™, we learned how to weave the Gospel into every Bible story and how to use The Wordless Book to share the Gospel. We highly recommend these classes to all parents, grandparents, teachers, and CEF staff!

What messages was that little girl receiving in those moments?

Through the aid of our senses, our brains can receive thousands of messages. God designed us this way so we can receive His message. He is actively communicating His glory and character to us every day, hour, minute, and second. However, our sinful nature makes it easy for us to miss God's signal.

On that flight, God reminded me of the importance of digital ministry. He is not wishing that any should perish. We want children everywhere to see and hear who God is and what He wants for them.



TWO MAJOR INITIATIVES



GO AND TELL!

Children can reach children for Christ! That's the premise of a program called *Go and Tell!* which focuses on children reaching children. The goal is to train saved children to share the Gospel clearly and biblically with the help of color-based Gospel tools. Training materials have been developed. Pilot programs have been conducted and we look forward to how the Lord will use this not only to reach more children, but to call some children into the ministry of *CEF*.

HARVEST TIME

Luai Patu, National Director of CEF Samoa

In 2021, we used the *Go and Tell!* curriculum to train a total of 70 child evangelists between the ages of 8 and 13, as well as 50 volunteer teachers and helpers, from our surrounding churches and Good News Clubs.

When the day of the outreach arrived, our evangelists went out by groups into the streets of Apia to share the Gospel. Some of our teams didn't come back until well after the outreach was over. Our group leaders gave us the reason: "They didn't want to come back." A total of 398 souls (young and old) accepted Jesus Christ as Savior that day!

The following year, many of those same churches were not able to participate because of COVID-19 restrictions, but one church decided to still go ahead with their own *Go and Tell!* outreach. CEF Samoa trained 55 child evangelists and 24 teachers and volunteers from that church. On December 10, 2022, they were sent into town and 167 people received Christ that day! Many pastors, leaders, and parents said after the program, "This should be a yearly event!"

CEF is emphasizing Christmas Party Clubs and Go and Tell! as ways for more children to hear about Jesus.



HRISTMAS PARTY CLUBS

For many years CEF has conducted Christmas Party Clubs around the world. Perhaps you have heard about Christmas Across Middle East Lands (CAMEL). There is now a new emphasis on this strategic means of reaching children and launching on-going Good News Clubs. In 2022, the effort for Christmas Party Clubs went global, impacting each of the eight regions of the world.

The strategy emphasizes multiplication. CEF staff invests in training so the number of workers is exponentially increased and the number of children hearing the Gospel at Christmastime is multiplied. In 2022, staff conducted over 11,000 trainings which prepared more than 167,000 workers and volunteers. These teams conducted over 169,000 clubs, reaching over six million children. They heard the true meaning of Christmas through last year's curriculum, Emmanuel: God with Us. Best of all, over 1.7 million children indicated they received Jesus as Savior. Next year we plan to further expand the reach of Christmas Party Clubs so millions more can hear the Good News.

Plans are also underway to establish 20,000 new Good News Clubs because of this outreach. The Lord used the Christmas Party Clubs to ignite a passion in the hearts of our volunteers. Pray for the children who heard and the many Good News Clubs that are starting.





FISHERS OF MEN

Taiwan has many temples full of false idols. One of them is called "King of Kings" and is the greatest god among them all. He has no images. No one knows who He really is ... but we do!

The workers at a local temple allowed us to host Christmas Party Clubs in front of their temple! The Lord helped us prepare a message just for them—a message to introduce them to the one true, living God! At the first session, only one child and one adult showed up. As I preached the Good News to them, a fisherman came and began to sell fish next to us. Soon, people from town were coming to the temple to buy fish and listen to the Gospel at the same time!

I am sure many people heard the message—our speakers made sure to project their voices. During the second club, four more children came. At the end of the club, three of them accepted Jesus as Savior. As we were leaving, we were filled with joy as the children sang a song from the Christmas Party Club, "Emmanuel".



HUMBLE FAITH

INTERNATIONAL CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWS





Mr. O's Bible

JESSE IRVIN OVERHOLTZER

was born in 1877 and raised in a Christian family but struggled regarding his own faith. At age 12, he expressed interest in personally receiving the Gospel, but was sadly told that he was too young. Doubts about his salvation plagued Overholtzer for years. The initial joy of salvation diminished as his gaze drifted off the cross and onto his own obedience.

One of the events that brought Overholtzer to a renewed understanding of salvation was the life of D. L. Moody. Overholtzer read an old biography of the evangelist and was at first unsettled. How was this imperfect man, with only a sixth-grade education, used so powerfully by God? In Overholtzer's own words, "I saw that [Moody] had something which I did not have the Holy Spirit's presence and blessing in his life and ministry."

When Overholtzer's family was quarantined for scarlet fever, he found he had plenty of time for Bible study. It was during this period of seeking truth that the Holy Spirit opened his eyes to the sufficiency of grace. He saw that it was Christ's righteousness, not his own, that made him right before God.

Trusting in Christ alone, Overholtzer found joy and peace. Years later, Overholtzer read a quote of Charles Spurgeon in which the pastor stated his belief that even young children could come to faith in Christ. Struck by these words and remembering how he had been turned away at age 12, Overholtzer conducted his own experiments and saw proof that children indeed could come to saving faith and even lead others to Christ.

Overholtzer went to Chicago to solicit the help of Moody Bible Institute in the founding of Child Evangelism Fellowship. One summer, he led 5,000 children on the streets of Chicago to faith in Jesus using The Wordless Book.

Both Moody and Overholtzer understood the importance of reaching young people with the Gospel. Each man's work with children was certainly a defining aspect of his ministry, but their bond is more foundational. Both Moody and Overholtzer acknowledged their own weaknesses and cast themselves fully on the grace of God. They understood that both receiving the gift of salvation and serving the Lord require humble faith. In unique ways, their lives displayed God's power to accomplish His purposes through those who have submitted themselves to Him in faith.





INCREASING YOUR IMPACT

n recent years, our government has put in place many new regulations and laws that govern the distribution of our wills and affect our current giving.
