

Thank you for your continued prayers and support for the Hope for Ukraine project. Over the last weeks due to summer ministries taking place in many locations, we have been blessed to take the Gospel and distribute DYWW booklets.

Children are inviting their friends to attend the programmes. Children showed great determination to attend the clubs yesterday despite the stormy weather.

In one village, a little girl was told by her teacher to go home and not stay at the 5 Day Club. However the little girl said, "I want to hear what is being taught about God. Teacher, we can't live without God!"

In another town, a mother (not a believer) came up to the team to ask if the club would continue. She said she would like her daughter to continue to learn about God.

Children visit their grandparents in the village during the summer – in this way they were able to hear the Gospel for a few days this week (even though they are city children).

In a village where the club is held in someone's yard, the host looked at the many children in her yard and said, "God sent you here to tell all these children about God".

A volunteer at the prayer time said, "I like it when there is a smaller group of children (12). It means you can know every child's name and pray for them individually."

Statistics:

4,431,400 Do You Wonder Why booklets have been printed and many of them already distributed. 135,000 backpacks, pens and Meet the King booklets have been purchased. They are at various stages. Over 122,000 backpacks have been filled and taken into Ukraine or given to Ukrainian children living in Europe. 125,316 Gospel bags have been prepared from Romania, Poland and Czech Republic.
