## Dear Prayer Partners,

At the time of writing, it is wonderful to be in Portugal for the commencement of the Spanish/Portuguese CMLC. When we were making final preparations for the students coming some doubts, fears and questions started to enter our minds. What if the students don't come? What if we have missed something? Have we enough food? Have we set the right budget? Doubts, fears, and questions!

I wonder how you feel today? It may be as you think of the many challenges in family and ministry life it is easy to become concerned and anxious, fear and doubt can easily discourage us and cause us to ask questions. Why is family life so difficult? Why do people not want to hear about Jesus? Am I wasting my time? Why is it so difficult to get people interested in my ministry?

Paul writing his final encouragement to the Christians at Philippi told them in Philippians ch 4 v 6-7 to be "careful (anxious) for nothing". What was he really saying? No matter what is happening around you, no matter what circumstances you face, no matter what people say about you, your faith in Christ, or about your ministry do not get anxious about these things but take them to God in prayer giving thanks for all your circumstances even though you do not understand. Why should we do this? Verse seven says that God is offering us a peace that goes beyond our understanding. One commentator says, "The peace of God is that tranquility of mind freeing the believer from fear and worry". God is offering you that peace today even though you may be filled with doubts, fear, and many questions. What does He want you to do? With a thankful heart for all your circumstances go to God "make your requests" known to Him. Elisabeth Elliot said, "The first thing you should do before crying on anybody's shoulder is to open your hands and lift your pain to God." Why should you take time to pray?

He is the only one who "can keep (guard) your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus".

1	Finland: Some of the workers and volunteers are meeting on the 1st and 2nd of this month. Please pray for us to get to know each other better and for a special and blessed time together.  Iceland: Please pray the Lord will supply the needs for camps held this month.
2	Sweden: 2 <sup>nd</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup> Pray for the 5-Days Club in Holsbybrunn this week. Greece: Please, pray for Stefanos as he speaks on Aug. 2nd in a big young people's conference in order to give the challenge they need to follow the Lord.
	Latvia: Praise God for the camps so far this summer and pray for all the children and young people who heard God's word. Pray they would understand and respond in repentance and faith.
3	Estonia: Pray for the children who trusted the Lord during summer camps and 5-Day Clubs, that they might grow in the knowledge of the Lord.
	Multimedia: Thank the Lord for the new Persian Adventure camp material based on the Life of Esther, which will be used in the summer of 2024. Pray that the translation and publication will take place in all 38 European languages.
4	Spain & Portugal: Pray for the 8 Portuguese students and 3 Spaniards who are doing the CMLC course in Portugal, so that some of them can be part of the CEF team in their respective countries.
5	Education Dept: Praise God for His help until now with the two CMLCs going on in Romania (full 12-week course) and Portugal (first 6-week module). In total 33 students representing 16 European countries are taking the training. Pray that God will call many of them into fulltime ministry.
6	Germany: For the southern part of Germany the month of August is the time of camps and other summer activities. Please pray for the camps of the local works in Franken (August 7-11), Tübingen (10-13) or Munich (12-18). May the Lord give lasting fruit.
7	Andrew & Beulah McMullan: 7 <sup>th</sup> – 11 <sup>th</sup> Please pray as we teach at a HBC this week that the children will come with hearts prepared to hear God's Word and that He will work in young lives.  Greece: The CEF worker, Sotiria Dino, will be teaching around 70 teens in a Bible camp, Aug. 7-15 Please, pray for all the teens to be touched
	by God.
8	IT Dept: Please pray for the development of a good website for Farsi-speaking children. Sister Rosa from Turkey will organize GNC Online and IT is helping with technical things.
	Digital ministry is significant for the future. In CEF we already have digital platforms like Wondersurf and BCC, but our prayer is that in the future we will see many more digital evangelistic materials present in countries.
9	Lithuania: Praise the Lord for summer ministries reaching 100+ children and 5+ children trusting Jesus as their Saviour. Praise the Lord

for more than 20 volunteers in three cities where summer outreach was taking place.

Italy: Please pray for a national director to lead the ministry in the whole country. Praise God for the children that have been reached in the new camp centre over the past months. Pray God will save many of them.

- 10 August Portugal: Thanks for the camps in Vendas Novas in July and for having the CMLC course. Let us pray for the team developing the camps in the Azores this month.
- lreland: Pray for the camps taking place throughout this month and especially for the camp centre staff as they have had a busy summer. We are so thankful for camp ministry, and the opportunity this presents to spend a week with children living out the gospel before them.
- Greece: We praise God for the 38 teens that came at CEF Camp at the end of July! There were some refugees, some immigrants and some very difficult teens, but at the end of the week they wanted to know more about the Lord and three prayed for salvation. Please, pray that God will continue to work in their hearts.
- Cyprus: We thank the Lord for the weeklong VBS that was held in July in Larnaka. Many children came and were interested in the Gospel. Please, pray that the volunteers will be able to help them grow spiritually.
- Switzerland: Please pray that we will find a new person doing the bookkeeping. Also pray for all initial training into the subject.

  We are currently considering doing a distribution campaign with tracts/booklets into mostly unreached areas of Switzerland (8 cantons in the centre of the country). Please ask the Lord for clear guidance.
- 15 Stephen & Grace Chambers: Please pray for Stephen, Grace and family this week as they are involved in an outreach to children with friends from their local church.
- Lithuania: Pray for the children who heard the Gospel this summer that God would grow Gospel seeds in their lives. Pray for the saved children that they have a Christian contact for discipleship.

Sweden: Pray for an outreach with the Gospel of John in Gothenburg in the beginning of September.
