SHORTFALL REMEMBERING PAUL REID MULTIMEDIA AND DIGITAL SUMMIT

As we look at how gracious God has been to the ministry of *Child Evangelism Fellowship®* in Europe this past year, we are grateful to bring the Gospel to boys and girls all across the continent.

More children were reached in face-to-face ministry than ever before, the number of children reached through online and digital means continues to grow, and "paper missionaries"—Gospel literature—continues to reach children on a daily basis through distribution.

Give God praise as you read stories of how He is changing lives across the continent!

KOSOVO

When our daughter was born, she was hospitalised for several weeks. While in the hospital we saw others who, like us, were also suffering. We prayed, and a desire to help these children and parents came to us. This year the desire came true! We met more than 60 children, parents, and paediatric staff when we had the opportunity to visit each room, give them gifts and a Christmas brochure. The children were in poor health, but still showed joy and a smile. Most importantly—we could give them hope by sharing our situation, how God works in miraculous ways and how He loves them very much. We thank God for this opportunity and for opening a new door.

POLAND

At the beginning of the year we helped a church in Żywiec, Poland to organise a winter day camp. In attendance were a mother and daughter invited by a family from the church. After one of the lessons on Nicodemus, the daughter asked her mother if she was born again. Her mother, who also listened to the lesson said she didn't know. On Sunday we learned that this mom had attended Sunday service for the first time after the winter day camp—she had never been invited before. She was also recently diagnosed with a serious illness. We were happy that mother and daughter could listen to the Gospel all week long. We pray she will experience the same thing as Nicodemus—new life.

MOLDOVA

Permission was given this year from the area education department of Balti to organise Christmas programs in all the schools in the town. We had a wide-open door but we didn't have gifts for the children, so we prayed. After a time of prayer, we remembered that very near to the school is the Emanuel Church. We met with the elders and presented the Christmas project along with the need for gifts and volunteers from their church. Very soon two teams of volunteers—along with gifts—were arranged and we preached the Gospel to more than 500 kids in that school. Pray with us for Emanuel Church and for the ministry they want to continue with the children.

IRELAND

Inters camps for 11–15 year-olds are always busy, noisy, and full of fun! Our Inters camp in August 2023 was very special. Over 80 young people enjoyed a great week together, and it was such a joy to see three of them come to faith in the Lord Jesus. The young Christians were encouraged to get involved in serving the Lord and as a result we now have 15 coming to learn about reaching children with the Gospel at our Junior Summer Outreach Training Course in July. We look forward to seeing these young people play a key role in reaching boys and girls in the future!


FRANCE






DIRECT MINISTRY 11 YEAR COMPARISON Number of children reached

CEF EUROPE MINISTRY 10 YEAR VISION

The vision to reach 5 million children each year with the Gospel is an inspirational one, and it requires the Lord to raise up many new workers and to sustain existing ones. These workers will recruit thousands of volunteers, train them, and help them reach more children with the Gospel.

In parts of Europe where it is not possible to raise all the support needed locally, God is opening doors for growth. This past Christmas, Ukraine and Russia were two of the countries where many thousands of children heard the Gospel. More opportunities exist today, but it is challenging to raise support in these and other places. Praise God for the Shortfall Ministry!

Based on those who have already committed to giving monthly, the remaining Shortfall need is an average of €178 per worker, for the month of April. We are currently seeking to help just over 300 workers.

This past February, CEF of Europe had one of its largest online gathering of workers ever for the Multimedia and Digital Summit. Around 200 workers from nearly every country in Europe attended the three-day gathering, which had simultaneous interpretation into six languages.

Open to all CEF workers, the goal of the Summit was to strengthen the vision of Every Child, Every Nation, Every Day through multimedia and

digital ministries. Attendees learned how direct, digital and distribution ministries can work hand-in-hand to reach more children through Gospel booklets and videos,



curricula and devotional books.

A session on applications for saved children was very much appreciated. Product production showing multiple perspectives—writers, illustrators, designers and translators—was shown, to which one person shared, "I learned many new things about your work and appreciate you all the more."

Breakout sessions gave everyone a chance to share problems and solutions to specific types of multimedia and digital ministry and how the Gospel was spread through creative means.

In the afternoons, special PRO sessions were organised for those specifically working on translation, editing and layout to better help those working with literature and media in their country.

"It was a privilege for me to be at the summit. The amount of printed and digital material that God has given to CEF is just amazing. And also that we have such a great team that is willing to invest in developing new things and update what is already there."
