1	Estonia: Pray for TCE-2 courses. We have two different courses in different towns running in April. Praise the Lord for Easter Clubs held around the country. Pray
	that children will grow in the knowledge of God.
2	Andrew & Beulah McMullan: We praise God for the opportunity to attend the
_	Portuguese 75 th anniversary service in the Vendas Novas Camp Centre in
	February. Please pray that God will continue to build this ministry and that Miguel
	will know God's wisdom as he leads the ministry. We praise God for the
	opportunity to share about the work in Soth West Europe. Please pray as we
	attend deputation meetings over the next weeks that God use us to be a
2	challenge and encouragement to His people.
3	France: From 3 to 6 April: the whole AEE France team meets for work meetings in
	the Paris region. May the Lord give us the wisdom to build well together,
4	according to His plans.
4	Finland: Thank God for the Esther Camp package and the attractive video
	advertisement in Finnish! We got orders already in February. Please pray that
	many people who are organising camps this summer would hear about this option
	and benefit from it, so that many children would hear the good news during the
_	summer all over Finland.
5	Ireland: We are planning a CMLC in Ireland this autumn. Please pray for students
	to enrol for the course and that God will challenge them about the need of new
6	workers to serve in the vacant areas in Ireland.
6	Germany: Once again, we pray for the German CMLC (Oct. till Dec.). So far, we
	have two fully approved applications. We pray for 20 participants of whom four
7	will be ready to join CEF in Switzerland and six to come to CEF in Germany.
7	Greece: The first two weeks of April, CEF camp will be full of working groups who
	will come to voluntarily help building different projects around the camp. We
	hope and pray that all go well with no hindrances, so that everything will be ready
0	for the Easter camp on April 29th (Greek Easter is on May 5th)
8	Cyprus: On April 8 th -13 th will be an English-speaking Teacher Training seminar at
	an International Church at Limassol. Andrew and Beulah McMullan and Linda
	Corry will be teaching. On Saturday 13th, there will be also a children's day event.

9	Sweden: We praise the Lord for the 10 years that have passed since we reopened

10	Spain: The teen retreat will take place in mid-April. We thank God for having been
	able to start these clubs with teenagers and we hope that God blesses this retreat

11	Linda Corry, Education Dept: Thank you for your prayers for the Refugee Highway
	Partnership in February. Pray for wisdom as we are currently following up on new
	contacts made and that they will develop into strong partnerships that will help us

They need our prayers and support. 14 Bogdan Bassara, Multimedia Dept: Thank the Lord for the Happy Easter booklet that is distributed around Europe from the middle of March to the middle of May as Easter in Eastern Europe is celebrated on May 5th. Pray for many children and their families that would read the Good News. Pray that God will use it! 15 Vilijam Valentini, Digital Dept: Please pray with us for the Unite materials and development of animated videos and audio materials. We believe this is a good way for children to have access to good and quality gospel-centred materials. 16 Claire Bain, European Partnership Ministry: Please pray that God would raise up more believers to support the shortfall project for workers who need support each month to carry out their ministry. We pray for a new generation of prayer and financial supporters for future generations of children who need to hear the 17 Netherlands: Pray to the Lord for the '75 clubs-campaign'. May the Lord touch the hearts of children's workers, pastors, elders and generous believers to take part in this campaign. 18 Belgium/Luxembourg: Praise the Lord that we were able to train 9 students for the TCE-3 course in March. Please, pray that many children will be touched by God's Word. Netherlands: praise the Lord we could organize a weekend camp in June for children from 7 to 12 years.
