

esus, the King of kings, gave His life on the altar of the cross and rose again as our perfect ransom. He gave the Great Commission to the church—the body of Christ: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations ..." (Matt. 28:19). Jesus' disciples are to take the Gospel to every nation, every people, every tribe, and every tongue.



Training staff and volunteers is essential:

- Training guards against mission drift, and it produces teachers who are effective, confident, and marked by excellence.
- · Training is key to exponential growth because it allows us to focus on multiplication rather than addition.

With increased responsibility, leaders receive additional training to lead effectively.

NATIONAL AND STATE DIRECTORS

MAKE A DIFFERENCE



This 12-week diploma program prepares men and women to evangelize and disciple children, train others to evangelize and disciple, and effectively lead ministry. In 2024, 26 institutes are planned around the world.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES INSTITUTE®

THROUGH TRAINING.

Teens attend a 1-2 week intensive training program to prepare them to teach 5-Day Clubs. God also uses it to call many into ministry with CEF as they catch the vision of reaching the next generation for Jesus.

CHRISTIAN YOUTH IN ACTION®

Good News Club training provides instruction to support the nearly 85,000 weekly clubs that meet around the world. Every club provides teaching for both the unsaved and saved child. CEF also offers specialized courses designed to increase effectiveness of teachers.

GOOD NEWS CLUB® TRAINING AND SUPER SEMINARS

Christmas Party Clubs are foundational in reaching 100 million children. Volunteers learn how to share the true meaning of Christmas with boys and girls around the globe through Christmas Party Clubs. Millions of children hear about Jesus and new Good News Clubs are launched by those who catch the vision of reaching the next generation.

CEF offers different types of training to prepare people for ministry and develop them as leaders. As more workers are trained, we will continue to move toward the goal of reaching 100 million children annually.

DEVELOPING AND DEPLOYING TOOLS EQUIPPING

t would be hard to underestimate the importance of the right tools for doing a job. Engineers spend hours perfecting tools to make the job easier, accomplish it with greater efficiency, and produce excellence. In *CEF*, we are committed to developing and deploying the best tools to evangelize and disciple the next generation and establish them in the local church for growth. We are diligently building a highway that includes materials for direct ministry, digital ministry, and literature distribution ministry.

DIRECT MINISTRY



Direct ministry refers to being faceto-face with children in a club setting. Each year we provide thousands of Boxes of Books to equip teachers around the world with tools to evangelize and disciple the next generation. Flashcards, memory verse

visuals, missionary stories, and devotional books make up the vast majority of these materials. Great attention is given to make sure materials are biblically accurate, culturally relevant, and clearly share the Gospel with boys and girls. Materials are then translated to ensure we reach children around the world. Currently, *CEF* literature is translated into 100 languages for use around the globe.

DIGITAL MINISTRY

The digital highway continuously expands, and *CEF* is committed to using it as a means to reach millions with the Gospel. The *U-Nite®* platforms and other digital ministries impacted nearly two million children last year. Good News Clubs are broadcast into Muslim strongholds and North Korea. Children are discipled on a daily basis as they visit one of the digital platforms.



DISTRIBUTION MINISTRY

Sometimes we distribute literature without a face-to-face presentation of the Gospel. For example, in Ukraine, over 4.5 million copies of Do You Wonder Why? were distributed. Distribution often takes place in the face of crises like war in Syria, the Israeli-Hamas conflict, earthquakes, tornadoes, hurricanes, and many other crises.

An example of rapid deployment came in the wake of recent unrest in Haiti. Within hours of the uprising beginning, CEF leaders convened to plan a way to get resources in place. We are now distributing Do You Wonder Why? and the Gospel of John in Haiti along with special Gospel bags that contain items for children.




COMING ALONGSIDE HIGHWAY BUILDERS

od has blessed CEF with hundreds of men and women who are called, gifted, and committed to reaching the next generation for Jesus. In some places these men and women can raise their full financial support. In many developing and closed countries, the only option is to support them from outside their country so they can serve full time. The Sponsor-A-National program comes alongside these men and women and provides financial resources. National missionaries are among the most effective missionaries because they know the language, understand the culture, are least impacted by political unrest in their countries, and are the most economical way to reach the next generation.

Over the last decade God has allowed us to support many more national missionaries through SPAN™. Recipients serve in 140 countries around the globe. This year 26 Children's Ministries Institutes will produce many new workers, and we project that we will have 1,800 SPAN recipients by the end of 2024. This represents a 220% growth rate in the last decade. National workers are key to reaching 100 million children annually. Please pray with us that God will continue to raise up men and women to enter the harvest field.

With the growing need for national workers, we are launching a new program to allow individuals, churches, businesses, small groups, and families to adopt a Sponsor-A-National recipient. Visit cefonline.com/spantheglobe and read testimonies of available missionaries. Perhaps the Lord has burdened you for a certain part of the world or those reaching a specific people group. You will be able to see the role they play in reaching the next generation and the support needed. When you adopt a worker, you will receive regular newsletters to help you pray for and encourage the worker you adopted. The average worker can be supported for \$300 per month or less. That's just \$75 per week or \$15 per day.

Lord.



USA MINISTRIES REJOICING IN STRONG GROWTH



USA Ministries has experienced unusual blessing over the last year. The growth statistics are amazing:

- The number of children attending Good News Club increased by 45%.
- The number of Party Clubs doubled and reached 224% more children.
- Children reached in face-to-face ministry grew 26%.
- Children watched over 1 million minutes of digital ministry.
- Professions of faith grew 63% to 51,217 (nearly 20,000 more this year).

We are grateful to Fred Pry for his leadership of USA Ministries over the last four years. He helped unify the ministry and navigate through the pandemic. Continuing his ministry with CEF at the International Headquarters, Fred serves as acting vice president of Administration.

LOCAL DIRECTOR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM EXPANDED

Through a generous gift from ministry partners we have helped 56 chapters in 35 states hire staff. The program provides financial assistance for salary, education, and materials for use in ministry. We praise the Lord for funds to help fill an additional 30 positions. Please ask God to raise up men and women who are called to help churches impact their communities for Christ.





- **CEF** has global impact. CEF ministers in more countries around the world than any other organization I know. They are active in 96% of the countries of the world!





- CEF exercises responsible stewardship.

STEPS TO REACHING 100 MILLION

urrently, by God's grace, Child Evangelism Fellowship reaches a little over one percent of the world's two billion children. Our vision is to grow to reach 100 million children annually by 2032. This God-sized vision is possible as we work and pray together knowing "it is not the will of my Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish" (Matthew 18:14). We are asking God to help us build a highway that will allow boys and girls from all over the world to hear and respond to the Gospel.



The graphic demonstrates how we can strive together to reach 100 million children annually.

Step 1—As Christmas Party Clubs continue to expand, they serve as a launch pad for gaining new volunteers and Good News Clubs.

Step 2—Training equips volunteers to serve effectively and gives them the skills to evangelize and disciple the next generation.

Step 3—Boxes of Books provide materials to equip a growing number of staff and volunteers.

Our founder, Jesse Overholtzer, prayed for an "army of evangelists that would one day encircle the globe." These first three steps recruit and train this army to reach the boys and girls.

Step 4—Good News Club, the flagship ministry of CEF, evangelizes and disciples boys and girls and establishes them in a local church. Increased church partnerships continue to strengthen this ministry.

Step 5—Children Reaching Children (CRC), Youth Challenge (YC), and Christian Youth in Action (CYIA) engage those we reach to reach more. Children and teens receive training to be on mission wherever God puts them.

From the army of volunteers, we recruit those God calls to be staff. We pursue this goal for one reason: to glorify God and live in light of His desire that "not one of these little ones should perish."

ETERNALLY GRATEFUL

MY LIFE WAS **CHANGED FOR ALL OF ETERNITY BECAUSE OF A** SIMPLE GOOD NEWS CLUB.

y own spiritual pilgrimage began more than 50 years ago through Child Evangelism Fellowship. I grew up in Normal, Illinois. One day on the bus ride home from school, a buddy of mine, Johnny, says, "Hey, why don't you get off at my stop tonight? There's this club and it's really great and I want you to come to it with me."

When I asked what kind of club it was, he replied, "It's a Bible club."

That was a losing proposition to me. Our family went to church. My mom was interested in spiritual things but my dad was not. As a ten-year-old, I didn't know if I believed any of it, but it sure was not working for my parents.

But Johnny spoke one of my love languages to this day: "They serve Kool-Aid and cookies!"

So I went to club, and I was not expecting what happened that day. First of all, I was not bored. Miss Jenny, the lady leading the Good News Club, was so creative as a Bible teacher. She used flannelgraph, and it was beautiful. And then she took this book with no words, just different colored pages, and simply explained the Gospel. Though we went to church, it was something I never heard clearly before.

I understood when she talked about us all sinning—that described me. Right about that time, I had stolen candy that was an


anniversary present from my dad to my mom. And I hid my tracks—I fed the leftover pieces to my dog so my dog got the spanking I deserved. I was carrying that guilt around.

Children know right from wrong, and that's why there's an openness to the Gospel at that age—that 4-14 window when their hearts are open. But it gets harder to reach them by the year.

That day, I asked Jesus to forgive my sins, believing that He died in my place and was sent by His Heavenly Father. That's now over 50 years ago. I understand it better today, but there's no doubt in my mind, that was the day I moved from death to life, from hell to heaven.

CEF still carries out simple, powerful Bible teaching like that. And it's not just about conversion. It's about setting that child on the road to lifetime discipleship. Sometimes we share with kids and they pray a prayer, but they need discipleship. CEF provides that too.

I'm an alum of CEF. My life was changed for all of eternity because of a simple Good News Club. And quite frankly, there's no possible way I'd be doing what I'm doing todayleading the global ministry of Walk Thru the Bible—without those roots in CEF. So I commend this ministry to you and I can't endorse it more strongly than to say, I'm eternally grateful for CEF.
